On November 26, 2020, a foundation rose from the ashes of the tragic passing of Zachary (Zac) Jacob Plantz. He was a Frankfort, Illinois native graduating near the top of his class at Providence Catholic High School. He was an all-state football selection and went on to earn a degree and become a rugby stand-out at the University of Notre Dame. Zac's career moves and commitments to his community were stepping-stones toward his ultimate life goal—to build a better city, a better country, and a better tomorrow for everyone he met along the way.

The Zac Plantz Memorial Foundation is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to shepherding young men and women who are committed to creating a better tomorrow. We will invest in young people by providing them with opportunities to grow academically, socially, and spiritually as they set out to establish inspiring legacies of their own. We honor Zac's commitment to the whole person by championing faith-based education, service & leadership, and health & wellness initiatives within our community.

We seek to empower young men and women to follow in Zac's footsteps by connecting them with transformative opportunities and resources in education, service & leadership, and health & wellness. These were the pillars of Zac's life, and we hope to spread his goodwill by funding experiences that will expand their perspectives of themselves (and the world) so that they can continue Zac's legacy and finish the chapters he left unwritten.

OUR IMPACT

The Zac Plantz Foundation (ZPF) is a not-for-profit organization established in November 2020 to honor the memory of Zachary Jacob Plantz. In his short time on Earth, Zac made an indelible mark as a son, brother, mentor, friend, and, above all, a shepherd. The foundation is dedicated to shepherding young men and women who are committed to creating a better tomorrow. We honor Zac's commitment to the whole person by championing faith-based education, leadership, and health & wellness initiatives within our community.

While we are a young foundation, we are proud of all that we've accomplished in the last 2.5 years. We've established 3 annual fundraising events which have allowed us to raise mental health awareness within the local community, invest money to support our mission, and award three scholarships to local high school students.

The Zac Plantz Foundation has also established partnerships with other non-profit organizations, including the U.S. Center for Mental Health & Sport and Athletes for Hope, to provide young people with opportunities to grow academically, socially, and spiritually as they set out to establish legacies of their own.

\$35,000

In the last two years the board has approved \$35,000 in funding for Athletes for Hope. The grant supported mental health awareness training for student athletes, coaches, and parents.

\$10,000

To date, the Foundation has awarded \$10,000 to the U.S. Center for Mental Health & Sport. These funds support mental health awareness training for student athletes, coaches, and parents.

\$27,952

In the last 2 years, we've captained the Zac Plantz Foundation Movember team, growing our mustaches and raising money in support of men's mental health awareness. The Zac Plantz Foundation has donated \$16,000 directly to the Movember Foundation.

\$168,900

To date, the Zac Plantz
Foundation has committed
nearly \$170,000 in full
and partial scholarships
to faith-based educational
institutions. These
scholarships will fund
students' educations at local
Catholic High Schools in the
Chicagoland area for the next
4 years, with plans to expand
our reach year over year.

\$400,000

The Board of Directors has established a \$400,000 endowment to ensure the long-term sustainability to ensure the long-term sustainability of the Foundation. This investment will allow us to grow our annual scholarship fund and award additional grants to organizations that share our values.

The Evening for Good Gala Event continues to be a night to remember! 350 guests spent time learning about the Foundation's 2023 impact and were the first to be introduced to our four new ZPF Scholarship recipients! Coach Niel MacDonald shared his inspiring story of resilience, and Chris Wyttenbach, Chief Program Officer of Athletes for Hope, shared how ZPF's funding (\$25,000 granted in 2023) helped expand the organization's impact.


